## <Rules of garbage disposal>

**Category:** Separate garbage by category  
**Time:** Place by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day  
**Place:** Only at designated place

※You can read this leaflet in 10 languages.



**Catalog Pocket**

- Garbage is collected also on national public holidays. (No collection on Saturday, Sunday and January 1-3)
- Collection may be cancelled due to natural disaster (typhoons etc). Do not put out garbage in typhoon weather.
- Can dispose of maximum 6 bags at a time.

## 1 Burnable Garbage Use only approved garbage bags



Designated days on every week

●Kitchen Garbage

Squeeze out the water from kitchen garbage and put it in the middle of the garbage bag.

## 2 Non-Burnable Garbage Use only approved garbage bags



Designated days on the 2nd and 4th week of every month

●Fan  
●Hair dryers  
●Vacuum cleaner  
●CD Player  
●Rice cookers

Separate codes and cut them to less than 1m and place in burnable garbage bags.

Small electrical appliances

Separate bags for small electrical appliances and other non-burnable garbage.

●Metals  
●Umbrellas  
●Pans, Kettles  
●Metal hangers

Other non-burnable garbage

●Light bulbs  
●Glass items  
●Non-broken ceramic  
●Cosmetic Bottles

Other non-burnable garbage

According to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, you can return them to the home appliance store.

**Personal Computers**

According to the Act on the Promotion of Effective Utilization of Resources, you must contact the personal computer manufacture to have it taken in.

## 3 Harmful or Hazardous Garbage, Batteries Use clear or semi-transparent bags



Designated days on the 2nd and 4th week of every month

●Fluorescent lights  
Place in a box or wrap with newspaper (do not use packing tape directly)

●Mercury thermometers  
place in clear bags and attach it on a box

Light bulbs are non-burnable garbage

Harmful

●Razors, cutters, sharp edges Knives, tools, etc.

●Broken glass, bottles

●Lighters  
place in clear bags without any other garbage

Hazardous garbage are wrapped in thick paper, label "キケン(dangerous)" and place in clear bags.

●Alkali or manganese batteries

place in clear bags without any other garbage Button-type batteries and rechargeable batteries are not collected. Please bring the items to shop with a collection box installed.

## 4 Recyclables Use clear or semi-transparent bags or bundle with a paper string

Rinse insides of cans, glass or Pet bottles

dispose plastic caps as burnable garbage

check for PET recycle mark flatten PET bottles

Designated days on every week

●wrapping paper ●note pads  
●paper packaging for chocolates, snacks, etc... ●comic books  
●magazines ●textbooks

remove materials other than paper (such as CD's attached in magazines and leather, cloth, or vinyl covers) as much as possible. →burnable garbage

Books, paper

can mix newspaper, advertisements

Newspapers

remove all tape and staples

Cardboards

rinse with water, cut open, and dry. cartons with aluminum or wax coating are burnable garbage

Milk cartons

underwears are burnable garbage

●clothes  
●old towels, bed sheets

Cloths, old clothes



Designated days on the 1st, 3rd and 5th week of every month

cut less than 1m long and make bundles

dispose of grass and leaves in clear or semi-transparent bags. up to 6 bags or bundles

dispose of large quantities over the course of several days.

Grass and Tree clippings

plywood, lumber, etc... coated with paint or antiseptic agent cannot be recycled. → burnable garbage or bulky garbage

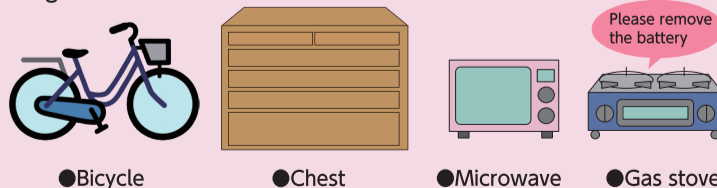

Garbage that does not fit into Naha designated garbage bags is considered bulky garbage. can also bring bulky garbage directly to the clean center. Bulky garbage is separated into two types according to sizes.

●300yen×2  
2 sticker pasted  
garbage over 1m in size or 10 kg in weight

●300yen×1  
1 sticker pasted  
garbage smaller than the large size

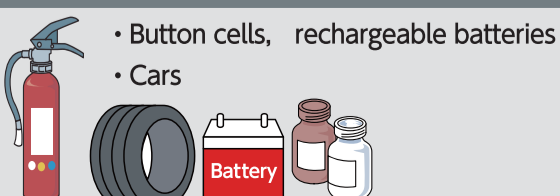
