Our Efforts

- Hand sanitizers are placed at the entrance and throughout the museum.
- Doors are open to promote air flow to the extent possible.
- Display counters and surfaces are routinely cleaned and disinfected.
- Transparent plastic shields are installed at the front counters.
- Trays are used when handling cash transactions.
- The staff are required to take their body temperatures, wear face masks and practice good hand washing.

To All the Visitors

- Please wear a mask when visiting our museum.
- · To avoid the crowds, we may limit the number of visitors. We ask for your understanding.
- · A body temperature check for each person will be performed upon visiting.
- · Visitors may be refused entry if they present with a fever or flu-like symptoms.
- · Please feel free to use hand sanitizers available throughout the museum.
- We recommend that visitors maintain a distance of 2 meters from others within the museum.
- Please do not touch the walls, display cases or any other surfaces due to transmission risk.
